Look to the round one through the square one?

Suddenly we have 'walls within walls' and the mezzanine level now has its landing, four rooms and doorways all boarded out and clearly defined. Sadly for us it marks the loss of a useful camera position for shots down into the hall, but the three window apertures remain an option. Our photo right shows Pastor's office which, in addition to the Velux roof window for natural light, provides him with an inspirational view through the square internal window across to the porthole on the rear wall which will be fronted by the wooden cross.



By far the largest of the upstairs areas is occupied by our new meeting room. With its pair of Velux style windows bringing in lots of natural light and the two internal windows, this is a wonderful space for junior church/Sunday school and other meetings as required. So how good it will be to be able to leave tables and chairs in situ and not have to clear the way for coffee time. So any guesses — will the coffee machine be sited in this room or in Pastor's office or just possibly in both?

Meanwhile, downstairs in the worship hall the team have made further progress towards completing the baptistry. The floor now has a water-tight concrete slab and the grey lightweight insulation blocks for the sides are set in place. Inboard of the insulation will be a wall of breeze blocks and then eventually tiling. The plastic plumbing for the filling and heating is now fed through the insulation and a large drain outlet is set in the corner. Don't worry about the ladder—gentle steps are part of the plan!
